Mentor-Protégé Program

On July 11, 2008, New Concepts & Associates, LLC; an SBA approved Joint Venture between New Concepts Management Solutions and Monterey Consultants; was awarded a four-year contract to provide program management support for the U.S. Army Office of Small Business Mentor-Protégé Program.

The Army Mentor-Protégé Program provides incentives to defense prime contractors to develop the technical and business capabilities of eligible protégés with the goal of increasing their participation in both prime contracts and subcontracts.

NC&A will provide managerial and technical support to the Army Mentor-Protégé Program Manager.

NC&A's support consist of data analysis of program participants, tracking performance of program agreements including milestones, deliverables and qualitative assessments; development of responses to inquiries for data from Congress, GAO and/or for public relations activities; coordinate and participate in outreach conferences and symposiums; perform financial analysis and projections; and recommend program improvements.
